## An Epochal Decision By Mitsubishi Electric Is An Integral Infusion

Integral Systems, Inc. (NASDAQ-ISYS), has announced that Mitsubishi Electric Corporation (Mitsubishi Electric) has selected Integral Systems' **EPOCH Integrated Product Suite (IPS)** to support its **DS2000** satellite platform.

This announcement marks **Integral Systems'** sixth commercial command and control contract signing in Asia in the last twelve months.

Under this key operational contract, Integral Systems will add capability to its **EPOCH IPS** to support the **DS2000** satellite platform, including all required telemetry and command processing, memory management, and orbit analysis. Upon completion of the effort, Integral Systems' EPOCH IPS will provide a highly precise, integrated environment for DS2000 satellite operations and mission analysis. Integral Systems' EPOCH IPS provides complete operations capability for real-time monitoring and control of all satellite and ground equipment systems and functions. EPOCH IPS supports satellite platforms from every major commercial satellite manufacturer in the world and is used to operate more geosynchronous communication satellites than any other commercially available system.
